SPSBS AFFILIATION RULES 2022

- 1. Classes must be confined to SPS-BS Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or to foals eligible for registration.**
- 2. Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.**
- 3. IN ORDER TO ENTER A STALLION CLASS AT AN AFFILIATED SHOW ENTIRE MALES AGED 4 YEARS OLD AND OVER MUST HAVE AN “S” NUMBER AND HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY THROUGH EITHER THE SPSBS STALLION ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO 2006 OR THE CURRENT SPSBS VOLUNTARY VETERINARY EXAMINATION. Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle badge. Inhand stallions 3 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle badge**
- 4. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be 4 years old and over. In ridden classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.**

- S2 YELD/ BARREN MARE (4 years & over)**
- S3 YEARLING (Colt, Filly or Gelding)**
- S4 TWO AND THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES**
- S5 GELDINGS, 2 YEARS AND OVER DRAKESHEAD BOWL**
- S6 MINIATURE PONY (Any age, sex, 34" & under at Maturity) LOFTHOUSE CUP**
- S7 PAIRS (Any age, sex) HAWORTHS ACCOUNTANTS TROPHY**
(To be judged on the quality of each pony and not as a matched pair)
- S8 BEST COLOURED PONY (Any age, sex, & colour except Black)**
- S9 YOUNG HANDLER**
(Handler to be 15 years or under on the day of the show. Hard hats must be worn by handler. No Colts or Stallions allowed. No Prize money awarded. Rosette to each competitor)
- S10 VETERAN PONY (Any sex. Pony to be 15 years and over)**
- S11 VETERAN HANDLER VETERAN HANDLER CUP**
(Handler to be 50 years or over. Pony any age)

CHAMPIONSHIP – ALL FIRST AND SECOND PLACE WINNERS CAN ATTEND

S11 FANCY DRESS (Class to commence 30 minutes after end of Championship)
(Exhibitors may be of any age, young children to be accompanied by an adult. No prize money. Rosette for all)
