LIGHT HORSE SECTION

Instruction to competitors

- 1. <u>Height Measurement.</u> All animals in height classes are liable to be measured on the showground. Animals may be measured without shoes, but if presented with ordinary shoes on, the measurer will allow half an inch. No allowance will be made for plates,
- 2. <u>Entry forms</u>. Competitors are requested to state on the entry forms address details for local rider class
- 3. <u>Judges</u>. The committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute. The judge's decision is final
- 4. Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk. It is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Committee or Members of Great Harwood Show.
- 5. <u>Children's Classes</u>. A written statement signed by the parent or guardian of the exact date of birth of the rider must be given on the Entry Form for the Children's Riding classes. If this is omitted the entry will not be accepted. The committee reserves the right to withhold any prize until a birth certificate has been produced.
- 6. <u>Objections</u> Any objections to be made in writing, and lodged with the secretary within 15mins with a £10 deposit.
- 7. <u>Safety.</u> The organisers retain the right to bar any horse or pony which they do not consider to be suitable, in order to safeguard others against accidents; entry fee will not be returned. Failure to comply will leave the competitor ineligible to receive future trophies. All riders and junior competitors <u>must</u> wear Hard Hats conforming to current standards, correct clothing and suitable footwear. Hard hats conforming to current standard are <u>compulsory</u> in all ridden classes. Chinstraps must be fastened. Spot Checks will be made. Beagler's are **not permitted**.
- 8. <u>Trophies.</u> Acceptance of a trophy by the holder will be deemed as sufficient guarantee that he/she undertakes to return the same to the society 28 days prior to the next society Show.
- 9. <u>Classes.</u> The committee retain the right to cancel or combine classes with insufficient entries.
- 10. <u>Ring Championship:</u> There will be a championship in each ring as per schedule, Supreme of show (Light horse section) to take place on conclusion of all ring championships.
- 11. Entries on day: Strictly CASH ONLY on day
- 12. Horseboxes and Trailers: Will be checked for foot passengers being brought onto the Show Field in rear of trailers/wagons

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2024 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each Area Qualifier class will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their card in the ring at all times and have their showing card signed by the judge as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership, *this MUST be done within 21 days of qualification.* It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 30th August – 1st September 2024 . No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid season in 2024.

TGCA TOYS In Hand and Ridden Classes

No known breeding required to enter these classes

TGCA Breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. **Part Bred classes**, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at "TOYS". The exhibit must have one parent that is bred traditional gypsy cob.

Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class $\underline{\text{MUST}}$ be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle.

Stallions and colts over the age of two, <u>MUST</u> be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook. Current TGCA members must present their Membership card and Qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature.

Non-members <u>MUST</u> receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.
